



Action Day – November 6th 2010

For our November action day we returned to the Harris Garden where we undertook the general garden maintenance of dead heading and pruning the roses in the raised bed and clearing the weeds in the side garden next to the white wall.

Our main project was to open up the area behind the seats at the rear of the garden, this involved the removal of a number of very old shrubs bushes and ivy. We also took the opportunity to cut back the bushes at the side of the wall which had overgrown onto the grass (this will allow the grass to re grow back).

There is still some work to be undertaken in the removal of a tree stump and the digging over of the soil in preparation for the planting of some new shrubs and grass seed to extend the lawned area behind the seats which we hope to undertake at a future action day.
